First, we would like to invite you to a **PARENTS MEETING FOR ALL SECOND-GRADE PARENTS ON Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, AT 7PM** where you will be taken on an introspective journey about your faith life and what you expect to be the faith life of your child. We promise not to take up too much of your time, but we do expect you to come and we know you will walk away believing that the time you spent was well worthwhile.

### **FIRST PENANCE...SATURDAY, February 2, 2018 AT 10 AM**

First Penance will take place on Saturday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 10am. Attendance is mandatory. A parent or parents are invited to come into the Church and sit in the pews along the back to be there for their child. No siblings in the Church during First Penance please, but a parent can wait in Wallace Hall with a sibling. The second-graders can leave one by one with a parent once they have gone to confession and said their penance. There will light informal refreshments following the service in Wallace for those who would like to “decompress” or wait for a friend. More details to follow.

### **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION SCHEDULE AND PRACTICES**

Two Communion ceremonies will be held this year to accommodate the number of Communicants in the program and their families:

-Saturday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 10:00 AM – For children who attend CCD on Sunday and Monday

-Saturday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 1:00 PM – For children who attend CCD on Wednesday

Children need to arrive at Wallace Hall 45 minutes before the start of their ceremony. If you need to change your child's Communion time, please contact Allanna in the Religious Education office. Also, if your child was not baptized at St. Patrick's and you have not yet done so in the past, please turn in a copy of your child's baptismal certificate ASAP to the Religious Education Office.

The Communion Rehearsal Schedule is listed below. These rehearsals are mandatory.

-For the 10:00AM Communion Ceremony – Monday, 5/6, and Tuesday, 5/7, from 3:45 – 5:00 PM

-For the 1:00 PM Communion Ceremony – Wednesday, 5/8, and Thursday, 5/9, from 3:45 – 5:00 PM

*Activity Buses will be available for all 4 rehearsal days*

### **COMMUNION ATTIRE & FLOWERS**

To ease questions regarding communion attire, please review the recommendations:

Boys: Dress slacks with white dress shirt, jacket and tie, or suit, white dress shirt and tie. Tie is not optional.

Girls: White or ivory dress veil/headpiece optional.

PLEASE NO FLOWERS WORN OR CARRIED, NO PURSES OR GLOVES DURING THE CHURCH CEREMONY...THEY ONLY SERVE AS A DISTRACTION.
